Entering the Education Program at the AET Designation

An individual may enter CET® Program as an AET and begin studies at the Advanced Curriculum based on the following steps and approval by the NAEC Education Committee:

- 1. Completion of the NAEC CET Education program application; to include a notarized letter by applicant of experience and documented verification of experience (ie: W2);
- 2. Completion of:
 - industry related educational training program (NEIEP) modules/courses that are substantially equal to or more comprehensive than the core curriculum of the NAEC CET® Educational Program and has documented at least 4,000 hours of on-the-job industry training;
 - o at least 6,000 hours of on-the-job industry training;
 - o at least 8,000 hours of on-the-job training related to the industry.
- 3. Completion of the OSHA 30 course.
- 4. Completion of the Level 1 (AET) Exam with a minimum score of 75%.
- 5. Verifiable completion of Skills Verifications included in the CET core curriculum (Courses 1-4) to be completed before Level 2 Exam.

This option will not be available to any individual currently enrolled or having ever been enrolled in the CET Program.
