



NEW ORLEANS COVID-19 MANDATES

What You Need to Know:

In order to be served in bars and restaurants, the city of New Orleans requires proof of vaccination or a negative COVID-19 PCR test taken within **72 hours** of dining. (**Rapid anti-body tests will not be accepted.**) All guests must provide *either* the front and back of their vaccination card, a digital card from a state sanctioned app, or a copy of the negative COVID-19 PCR test result along with their ID. There is also a mask mandate in place for all indoor activities.

When picking up badges at the NAEC registration desk, we are requesting that all convention attendees show proof of vaccination or a negative COVID-19 PCR test taken within 72 hours.

If you are unvaccinated:

- We **STRONGLY recommend** that you take a PCR test and have results in hand **before landing in New Orleans.**
- Attendees arriving with a PCR test will, depending on their length of stay, need another test to be able to attend all events throughout the show.
- NAEC will be providing complimentary **Covid PCR testing location on site at the Convention Center** for your convenience on Tuesday afternoon from **12pm - 5pm** and Wednesday morning from **7am to 12pm**. Attendees will receive their results same day.

If you are vaccinated:

- For your convenience, we recommend that you have a photo of your vaccine card, front and back, for your stay in New Orleans.
- Once you have shown your card at registration, you will not have to provide any further proof throughout the show

We are committed to your health and safety throughout the show. As part of that commitment, we are taking additional precautions with disinfecting our meeting spaces and utilizing larger venues to allow for safe distancing during activities.
